Objectives of the Cell

The main objectives of the SC/ST Cell are the following:

- To provide necessary assistance to scaffold teaching, learning and training of SC/ST students.
- To ensure proper implementation of various Programmes/ Schemes of the State and Central Governments, UGC and other agencies for the welfare of SC/ST students.
- To provide information on the scholarships, stipends and other assistance available for SC/ST students from various agencies.
- To arrange programmes for developing Employability Skills, Life skills, Aptitude & Reasoning Skills, Computer Skills of SC/ST students.
- To ensure equity and justice for the SC/ST students.

Scope of the Cell

The Cell will

- Examine the availability and implementation of welfare programmes for the SC/ST students.
- Look into the problems encountered by SC/ST Students on Campus and respond to their grievances and issues in a time bound manner.
- Ensure that Scholarships and Assistances from Governmental or Non-Governmental agencies are disbursed on time.

Functioning of the Cell

The SC/ST Cell functions in the college under the supervision of a committee chaired by the Principal. A senior faculty member is the Convenor of the committee with four members in the committee, including the Convenor.
