## Rubaroo- Agaaz-e-baatcheet October 2018

Rubaroo, an NGO, supported by the **British Deputy High Commission, Hyderabad**, and **iPartner, Delhi** brought back its flagship programme, *Agaaz-e-Baatcheet*, season 2, from October 2018.

Rubaroo has invited VGDC, Vidyanagar to partner for '*Agaaz-e-Baatcheet*', a leadership programme with 50 Youth Champions in Hyderabad. Department of English has taken up the initiatives and VGDC has consented to be a community, zone and event partner.

'*Agaaz-e-Baatcheet*' - a call to 'initiate a conversation' on Interfaith, is meant to be a platform where 50 Youth Champions will come together to celebrate the many cultures and diversity of Hyderabad. These Youth Champions, representing diverse partner institutions and backgrounds, will go through a leadership journey where they will learn about themselves and engage with social issues, to lead change initiatives within their communities. *Agaaz-e-Baatcheet* begins with a 3-day orientation workshop in the month of October (23<sup>rd</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup> October 2018). The Youth Champions will then prepare and set-up their Social Action Projects in a form of *Youth Kafes* and reach out to more youth during the Interfaith Week starting from 11th-18th November 2018.

**Being a community Partner**, the faculty gave an orientation to all the first, second and final year students. Students who have shown interest were nominated from the college.

Students had to register online by filling up a form, and based on their application out of 20 students, 12 were selected and were divided into two batches. Batch one had a 3 day Orientation at Madina College, Himayatnagar and Batch 2 at MANUU, Gachibowli. They participated in the 3 day programme to become Youth Champions..

**Feedback:** students were greatly satisfied as the programme gave them a different exposure and they said it helped them to overcome their stage fear and improve their communication skills. These youth champions will conduct youth cafes/ addas and in turn transfer the inputs they learnt to others.

## FIELD TRIP TO HYDERABAD LITERARY FESTIVAL (25-27 JANUARY 2019)

Department of English had organized a field trip to Hyderabad Literary Festival at Hyderabad Public School; a three-day event that celebrated creativity in all its forms. 150 students, from B.A., B.Com. and B.sc. attended the festival along with the faculty.

**25<sup>th</sup> January:** the festival began with a host of authors, artists and literature enthusiasts converging at the Hyderabad Public School Campus at Begumpet. The festival focused on Gujarati regional language and China was the guest nation for the 3-day programme. The faculty and students attended the opening ceremony, followed by panel discussion on the ragging issue of “Me TOO”, the students actively participated in the question and answer session and empathized with the victims.

The book stalls and art exhibition grabbed the attention of the students. The ambiance and elite crowd attracted the students and ignited a desire to be one among them.

**26<sup>th</sup> January:** The students visited **Digital Creativity Workshop** organized by R.J, Hashmi. The show demonstrate how youngsters can use the power of digital platform t bring about the positive change in the society. Students participated in the workshop and learnt how to create content on a particular topic. They were overwhelmed to learn and know about the opportunities in the digital world.

**YounghistaanNukkad Corner:** The Nukkad Corner was full of energy, it enthralled the students. They danced and tapped to the music played. The show excited the students and gave wings to exhibit their talent. They also enjoyed the flash mob show and street play organized at the festival.

**27<sup>th</sup> January:** The students attended a **workshop on how to write a movie script**. They were introduced to the essential elements of a screen play including plot, structure, scenes and sequences to write a screen play. This was followed by **Yaadien- Kafi Azmi** read by Shabana Azmi. A documentary was screened on the life of Kafi Azmi, documenting his struggle in the film industry, his ideologies and high and lows of his life. Shabana Azmi and Amita Tiwari interacted with audience after the screening. Students actively participated during the interaction session.

The 3-day Hyderabad Literary Festival came to an end on Sunday, leaving the enthusiastic students longing for more.



Brief report	<p>ICRISAT conducts agricultural research for rural development. It was established in the year 1972. It is operated by the UN. It is located in Patancheru, which is one of the 15 Internationally situated centers. The center occupies an area of 3500 acres which involves 10 ponds, nearly 120 different varieties of crops and 200 different varieties of birds.</p> <p>We the team of staff and students of sciences visited ICRISAT on 30-01-2019, FN. We were assisted by a senior scientist Mr.MM. Sharma. He showed us videos, related to the research in ICRISAT. The video shows that ICRISAT has adopted a village named Kothapalli, and conserved water through water shed management system. The students and staff were taken on a farm visit, where they were shown the methods of growing high yielding varieties. We also had a visit to Biotech lab where GM crops were developed. The campus is having a combination of red and black soil that makes it suitable for growing different varieties of crops. Students enjoyed and learned a lot about the research going on in there.</p>
